The Friends of Latrobe City Libraries wish to submit the following points in relation to the Hazelwood Mine Fire Inquiry:-

- The Morwell Library was closed for 2 days in the first week of the fire due to the smoke conditions.
- This closure inconvenienced the public usage of this facility
 - for accessing information,
 - borrowing,
 - using the free internet available to the public who do not have their own equipment or connection.
- One staff member, because of personal health risk, was relocated for the entire time of the fire.
- Other staff members were rotated to other towns on a daily basis to reduce the risk of health conditions.
- One monthly scheduled evening meeting for the Friends of Latrobe City Libraries needed to be relocated to another town due to the possible health risk. A number of our members are in their senior years and their personal health can be put at risk with increased breathing difficulties.
